TRACI

CAM

Oh my god can you believe?

TRACI

See, scrubs are in now, I told you.

CAM

They're such a look, very fall of 2022, very forward thinking.

TRACI

I am forward thinking aren't I?

CAM

You absolutely are.

FREDDIE

Hi, sorry I couldn't help but overhear from the seat across the aisle that you're wearing scrubs, I have this bad rash on my arm, look. Where might I have gotten this from?

TRACI

Excuse me?

FREDDIE

You're a doctor, aren't you?

TRACI

No, why would you think that?

FREDDIE

You're wearing scrubs, I just thought-

TRACI

No, I'm not a doctor, can you get your rash away from me.

FREDDIE

Okay, okay...

CAM

That was odd.

TRACI

It's like no one on this plane knows the first thing about fashion.

CAM

We're connecting in Omaha, Nebraska, they probably don't.

Stewart walks down the aisle.

STEWART

Hi, Traci, remember me?

CAM

Oh my god you were at the resort, right?

TRACI

Oh yeah yeah, 5D?

STEWART

Yeah, yeah, um I just-, so I think I

might have eaten something and I just keep having to use this darn bathroom. You just can't keep me out of there. Explosive, if you know what I mean. All 4 bathrooms too, front and back of the plane, so nobody is safe, ha ha... anyways, as a person wearing scrubs, I was wondering if you had any medical advice for me?

TRACI

Oh my god, I'm not a doctor, why does everybody assume that I am?

STEWART

TRACI

FREDDIE

TRACI

CAM

STEWART

TRACI

Oh my god, You can't-

STEWART

It's just-...Traci, I'm scared.

TRACI

Well, when we land, you should speak to a doctor!

FREDDIE

At the front of the plane is a flight attendant.

ALEX

We need a doctor! Is anyone a doctor?!

CAM

ALEX

You, in the scrubs, come up here right

TRACI

ALEX

NARRATOR
